


Colour in the bees

How to make a bee watering station



Creating a bee watering station is a simple and thoughtful way to provide clean drinking water for our buzzing friends. Bees, like humans, get thirsty and need access to a reliable water source. Here are some easy DIY ideas for bee waterers.

Materials needed

- Wide, shallow container (e.g. a frisbee or large dish)
- Glass pebbles or marbles

Step-by-step guide

1. Fill the container

Pour the glass pebbles or marbles into the container.

2. Add water

Ensure the container is large enough to hold 2 cups full of water.

3. Watch the bees arrive

Bees can now land on the pebbles and safely drink.



Remember, bee watering stations are essential, especially if your beehive isn't near a natural water source. By providing clean water, you're supporting the health and well-being of these vital pollinators.
